THE MIDLAND SCHOOL

A NJDOE - approved, private school, Midland offers a comprehensive special education program for students, ages 3 to 21. We partner with public school districts throughout N.J. to educate children with I/DD.

Our school's community is vibrant, supportive, and engaged, with a common purpose: to provide programs of the highest quality to help all students reach their highest level of achievement and independence. We create a safe environment where students are appreciated for who they are.

EXPLORES (DAY HABILITATION)

Explores is one of Midland's signature programs for adults with I/DD, 21 years and older, offering meaningful choice, enrichment and personal development. Our goal is to provide these adults with the opportunity to explore new activities, continue their skill development, and become integrated into the local community. Located just a few miles from Midland's main campus, the Midland Explores program operates 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., five (5) days per week.

EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

Midland offers adults with I/DD employment opportunities to help each individual reach their full potential. Partnering with local businesses, our objective is to provide supports that lead to competitive, integrated employment.

Our services include extended employment, prevocational job training, supported employment, and long-term follow along. Our training facility is a sheltered workshop accredited through CARF.



THE MIDLAND FOUNDATION

Midland relies on the generosity of our friends, families, and the greater community to support these life-changing programs and services. The Midland Foundation's objective is to raise funds to cover the gap between funds available and funds necessary to support Midland. The Midland Foundation runs three annual events – The Midland Golf Classic, Midland Goes to the Movies with PNC and Move for Midland. The Foundation also coordinates volunteer groups that donate their time and talents to indoor (Work Center) and outdoor (Building and Grounds) work – mostly in the fall and spring.
